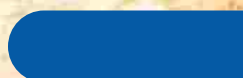

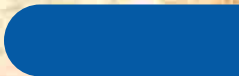

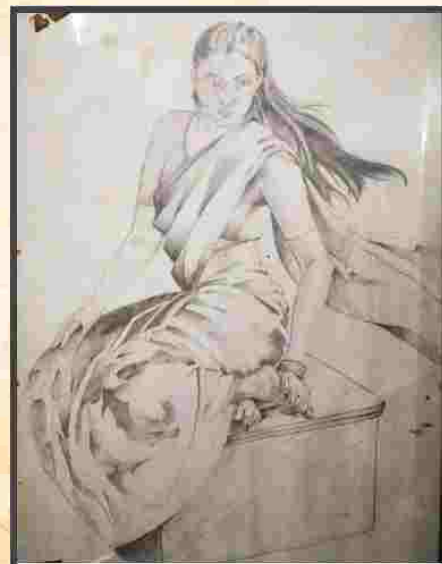

Irrespective, of his Perspective.

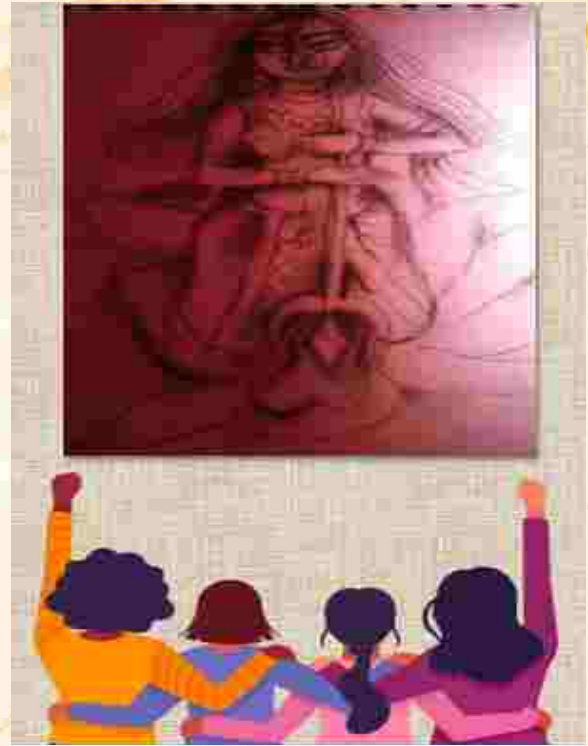
